The event will be held at the Kukini Facility at 16-1208 Rd #1 Hawaiian Acres, Mountain View, HI, 96771. Directions: Leave Hilo on Hwy 11 heading towards Volcano. Keep going past Keaau and Kurtistown. Once you pass the 13 mile marker, turn left onto South Kulani (at the traffic light). Follow that until it ends in a T intersection, turn left into Hawaiian Acres. You're now on Road 1. There's a sharp turn to the right and the property is the 4th or 5th driveway on the right. The property is fenced and there are lots of bushy palm trees. The house is blue with white trim and you'll be able to see the covered building in the back. If lost call 640 4373 (Sandy).
