Jeff Lyons Workshop
“Putting Distance Handling into Practice”
Saturday August 20, 2022

Instructor: Jeff Lyons is a highly sought-after and gifted agility instructor, whom we are blessed to now have living here on the Big Island. He is a seasoned competitor who has competed in several different agility venues, now competing mainly in NADAC. He typically works between 20 and 40 feet from the dog’s path. If you have ever seen him run his dog Sam, you know that he handles entire courses from inside a small “square” on the field, at times being more than 70 feet from his dog! Jeff is familiar with handling dogs of varying sizes, running styles, and speeds. If you previously registered for Jeff’s seminar in 2017, which was cancelled due to a family emergency, now is your chance!

Schedule: there will be two four-hour sessions, the first from 8:00 a.m. till noon, the second from 1:00 p.m. till 5:00 p.m. The morning session will be designed for teams new to agility or who have limited experience in distance handling. The afternoon session will be geared toward increasing distance-handling confidence and applying advanced distance-handling techniques for teams who are already competing in Elite or Open classes or already have some level of competence in handling from a distance. In addition to working on practical skills and drills, Jeff will also provide insights into the philosophy of distance handling, strategies and rules for NADAC Gamblers and Chances, and hints for recognizing and avoiding common traps. He will personalize the instruction for each team, so if the class that best suits your level does not fit your schedule, feel free to register for the other session. A maximum of 10 working spots will be available *per session*. Audit spaces are unlimited. Get your registrations in early to secure your spot!



Fees: For OIDA members, fees per session are \$65 for a working spot or \$20 to audit. Fees for non-members are \$75 or \$25 to work or audit, respectively.

What to bring: If your dog needs certain treats or toys for motivation, be sure to bring those! Also, bring whatever snacks/drinks you may wish to consume. Some crating is available on site, but you may wish to bring a crate for your dog. Bring a notebook in order to take good notes for future reference! Bring an eager attitude



and a happy (maybe hungry) dog.

Location: This seminar will be held at Kukini Field: 16-1208 Rd. 1, Hawaiian Acres, Mountain View, HI. Coming from Hilo, take Hwy 11 toward Volcano. You will pass Keaau and Kurtistown. About ½ mile past the 13-mile-marker, you will see the traffic light for turning onto South Kulani. Turn left (makai) at the light, follow that road to the end. Turn left at the T, which will take you to Road 1. After a sharp right corner, Kukini Field will be the 5th driveway on the right. Look for a blue house with white trim. The property is fenced. Covered building with field is in the back.
