At Kukini Dog Agility Field in Mountain View

We are blessed to have Scot Seo from Oahu coming to teach 4 Seminars! Scot has been training dogs since 1981, and teaches both Agility and Obedience/Rally. His training philosophy is to teach you to train your dog to “*want to*” work for you rather than to “*have to*” work for you. The goal is that you and your dog will be *happy* working partners with great connection. Scot will show you how to do this through motivation and positive reinforcement. He believes that connection with your dog, and the dog having fun, are the most important aspects of the sport. Once those are in place handling skills can be worked on. Every dog is unique so a variety of methods may be used. His dogs Katana and Kodachi have won titles in obedience, rally and agility, including the amazing Katana earning both MACH (Master Agility Champion) and PACH (Preferred Agility Champion) all in Hawaii!

The seminars will focus on handling strategies, including how to build focus and drive. Saturday’s seminars will be conducted on a Regular agility course, Sunday, Jumpers With Weaves will be set. The morning seminars will be designed for novice-level dogs; the afternoons will be designed for more advanced teams. Working spots are limited to ten for each seminar. Auditing spots are unlimited. Below is a detailed description of each seminar.

Saturday 8am – noon, Novice/Beginner: Handling Strategies, Standard Course.

Training for beginner or novice teams on Saturday will focus on learning the best handling strategies for helping your dog know where you want him to go. If you have particular questions or problems, be sure to let us know in advance of the seminar, and Scot will incorporate that into the teaching. He will tailor training to the level of your dog.

Saturday 1pm – 5pm, Advanced: Handling Strategies, Standard Course.

For advanced teams, Scot will focus on teaching advanced handler strategies, including work on creating focus and drive in your dog. He will also cover how to get the dog to turn away from the handler at a distance, such as in Chances courses. Again, he will tailor the training to the level of your dog.

Sunday 8am – noon, Novice/Beginners: Handling Strategies, Jumpers With Weaves.

Sundays course will be a jumpers course with weaves, which presents unique challenges to dog and handler. If you are having any particular difficulty in Jumpers courses, be sure to let us know in advance.

Sunday 1pm – 5pm, Advanced Handling Strategies: Jumpers With Weaves.

The afternoon will be designed to help more advanced teams strategize and execute advanced handling moves to help your dog be successful on the more difficult Excellent/Master-level courses.

Location

This seminar will be held at Kukini Field: 16-1208 Rd. 1, Hawaiian Acres, Mountain View, HI. Coming from Hilo, take Hwy 11 toward Volcano. You will pass Keaau and Kurtistown. One-half mile past the 13-mile-marker you will see the traffic light for turning onto South Kulani. Turn left (makai) at the light, follow that road to the end. Turn left at the T, which will take you to Road 1. After a sharp right corner, Kukini Field will be the 5th driveway on the right. Look for a blue house with white trim. The property is fenced. Covered building with field is in the back.
