

**Orchid Isle Dog Agility
General Membership Meeting
11-28-25
Kukini Agility Field**

The meeting was called to order at 11:21 a.m. by President Sandy Leggett. Board members present include Sandy Leggett, Marchand Green, and Mary Jo Stevenson Fullen. OIDA members who were present but not on the Board are Tobi Feves, Karen Lukela, Eileen O'Hara, Shasta Fox, Donna McClung, Angelic Ebbers, and Karin Riedel.

President's Report. President Sandy Leggett welcomed everyone and let them know that the membership had been called for nominations or willingness to serve on the OIDA board. She stated that the positions that will be up for election this year are President, Treasurer, one two-year At Large position, and one one-year At Large position. Positions that are continuing through next year are Sean Fendt as Vice President, Mary Jo Stevenson Fullen as Secretary, and Michelle Escobar as At Large board member.

Nominations were opened. Eileen O'Hara nominated Sandy Leggett for President. Donna McClung seconded the nomination. Sandy nominated Donna McClung for Treasurer; Eileen seconded. Sandy nominated Marchand Green for the two-year At Large position; Tobi Feves seconded the nomination. Sandy nominated Shasta Fox for the one-year At Large Position; Eileen seconded the nomination. There were no further nominations, and all agreed with these nominations. Nominations were closed.

Sandy announced that elections will be electronic and that Sean Fendt will send out an email with a link to follow for voting online. The email needs to be sent within three days of this membership meeting. There will be a virtual Board Meeting to count and validate the election results.

Treasurer's Report. Treasurer Marchand Green reported that the total in the OIDA bank accounts is \$6,550.85, \$3,737.67 of which is in checking, and \$2,813.18 is in savings. She reported a profit of \$181.62 on the Terri Rolph workshop. This profit resulted from Angelic Ebbers reducing field rental fees to prevent the club from incurring a loss on the event. Eileen moved, and Sandy seconded to approve the Treasurer's Report. All were in favor.

Membership Renewals. Tobi Feves reported that the membership renewal forms have been mailed to current members. She alerted everyone that there are three places to sign on the forms.

Up-Coming Events. President Sandy Legget asked the members present at the meeting what they would like to see for upcoming events and how OIDA can increase participation. Angelic Ebbers offered that her students would want to participate in a fun run—not in trials. She also mentioned the Pahoa Christmas parade scheduled for December 6. Kukini Dog Agility will again be participating in the parade (at the organizers’ request). She invited OIDA members to join them in the parade with dogs that can handle the stress of walking with other dogs. They carry a banner, which is also used for a jump to demonstrate agility skills. This is one way to get the community interested in the sport of agility.

Mary Jo reported that OIDA was working with Beth Hostetter from OneMind Dogs to lead a workshop when she and her husband come in February to celebrate their anniversary. However, Beth’s suggested dates for the workshop conflicts with the date of an Agility Trial on Oahu, which would affect the Oahu agility teams’ availability to participate in the workshop. Beth was not able to change her dates, and is now scheduled for just three days in Kona, but is willing to return to the Big Island to teach a workshop at the end of 2026 or beginning of 2027.

Equipment Update. Mary Jo asked if Sandy had an update on the repair of the agility timers. Angelic reported that Sean, who is repairing/revamping the timers had to order a few parts. She will check with Sean on his progress in the repair.

Sandy reported that the OIDA agility equipment is currently being stored for free at Aloha ‘Īlio Rescue’s new location. There is a possibility of OIDA teaching classes, holding events, or practicing at this location in the future. Angelic mentioned that she is currently working with students, equipping them to teach agility.

Adjournment. Sandy moved, Angelic Seconded, to adjourn the meeting. All were in favor. The meeting was adjourned at 11:52 a.m.
